Scrutiny Review Topic	<b>The Development of an Accountable Care System for Cornwall</b>
Terms of Reference	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To understand the rationale behind the establishment of Accountable Care Systems across the NHS in England and specifically for Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly.</li>   <li>2. To consider the option put forward for integrated strategic commissioning as part of a Cornwall and Isles of Scilly Accountable Care System (including the ones discounted and take a view on which is more likely to achieve the desired outcome) and the route map to achieve it.</li>   <li>3. Within the preferred option, ascertain how democratic control and clinically led commissioning can be retained.</li> </ol>
Scope restrictions	Provider form would be beyond scope and could be addressed in a future inquiry or Committee process.
Nature of Review	<p>Time bound inquiry utilising witness sessions - focusing on strategic commissioning.</p> <p>Proposal for four sessions</p> <p><b>Session One:</b> December 2017 To confirm what strategic commissioning is. Scene setting and provision of context of what is an accountable care system Presentation by NHS England and overview of Cornwall and Isles of Scilly thinking</p> <p><b>Session Two:</b> January 2018 Evidence from other areas Detailed overview of options and preferred option</p>

	<p><b>Session Three:</b> January 2018 Possible confidential session to discuss the preferred option prior to its publication</p> <p><b>Session Four:</b> January 2018 Discussion of the preferred option (in public following its publication) and how would it work. Envisaged Outcome	To recommend to Health and Adults Overview and Scrutiny Committee (for onward recommendation Cabinet in February 2018 and Kernow CCG Governing Body) a preferred option to support the development of integrated commissioning of health and social care in Cornwall and promote the development of integrated health and care services.
Timescale	Work envisaged between December and January to report to an extraordinary Health and Adult Social Care Overview and Scrutiny Committee in late January/early February 2018.
Status of the Review	The work of the panel would be held in public *unless a confidential meeting is required regarding the preferred option before publication to the public and decision makers
